## ENCAUSTIC EFFECTS WITH ACRYLIC

### Supply List

**Acrylics:** Some samples of new paints and acrylic products will be provided for each person to experiment. Please bring any of your favorite paints, mediums and gels for larger works.

**Primed Painting Surfaces, bring several (at least 5-10 surfaces)**

Bring some smaller surfaces (8" x 10") for experiments, & some larger sizes if desired. Sturdy supports only, such as Art Alternative's Canvas Boards, primed cardboard or primed masonite. Avoid flimsy surfaces such as paper. If surface is raw, please prime with gesso.

**1 Roll of Absorbent Paper Towels**

**A Sturdy Palette**

The palette should be large enough to mix many colors, or in a quantity to handle many color mixes. Uncolored, clear or white works best. Suggestions: 20-30 white non-absorbent picnic plates (coated paper ones at least 9" diameter), Disposable Paper Palette Pads, Freezer Paper wrapped around masonite. Avoid Wet Palettes or sponge type palettes.

**1 large (24 – 48 oz.) low wide-mouth Plastic Container for water** (coffee cups or other unstable, narrow mouth containers will not work.)

**A painting knife (a palette knife with stepped down handle)**

**Several Favorite Soft Haired Brushes**

Bring a variety of flat, round, large, small. Please bring some soft haired (synthetic) brushes. Stiff bristles (ie. hog's hair) are OK, just make sure you also have some soft ones for blending.

**1 or 2 Plastic Grocery Bags** (for transfer techniques, & garbage at your table)

**Water Sprayer**

**Scissors or other cutting tool**

**A small soft rag** (A 6" piece of an old sheet is preferable)

**A small black & white xeroxed image for transferring.**

Must be ONLY from a copier, not computer printer or inkjet. Line work & high contrast work best. Keep light, not too dark. Suggestions to Xerox: (your drawings, a magazine or book image, a photograph) as long as it is black & white, from a copier.

**Optional: Blow dryer for quick drying layers** (hair dryer not heat gun)

Plastic wrap. This is helpful to carry wet work home.

Images for reference (magazine, photographs or drawings)

Pencil and paper for notes

Apron or wear painting clothes
